

THE COST

Jesus warned us about counting the cost before deciding to follow Him: "But don't begin until you count the cost…" (Luke 14:28). He made it clear that we are to submit to Him and be willing to face suffering and tough times just like He did. However, as a Christian, God enters your life by the Holy Spirit and teaches, encourages, strengthens and helps you even in times of failure. As you surrender control of your life to Him He will give you new desires and the power to change…this is a life long process.
